1 GOAL

This document explains to a technical audience how to create conforming Interactive Data documents, with specifications as to the use of the eXtensible Business Reporting Language [[XBRL](#)] and Dimensions Specification [[DIM](#)] for the submission of disclosures. Readers should be familiar with Interactive Data as described in the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval (EDGAR) Filer Manual [[EFM](#)] and the EDGAR XBRL Guide [[EXG](#)].

The taxonomy covers all the relevant disclosures, although their corresponding XBRL data items depend on the Form (N-1A, N-2, S-6, and N-8B-2) and therefore may be dependent on the corresponding taxonomies, Open-End Fund [[OEF](#)], Closed-End Fund [[CEF](#)]. The taxonomy linkbases and entry points do not, on their own, distinguish between required disclosures and optional ones; refer to the Form's instructions for this information.

The taxonomy guide does not provide interpretative guidance for any rule.

1.1 Notations

Literal technical syntax appears in `fixed width font`.

XBRL concept and member names never contain hyphens (-); they appear only in tabular displays for long concept names to introduce line breaks that improves layout in the document.

1.2 Document status

Technical details may change between this document and future versions to be published upon their implementation in EDGAR. Element names, labels, or links may change to become more explicit or compact. References to forms, exhibits and regulations may be revised to provide greater or less specificity. New data validations specific to FND may be added to, or removed from, EDGAR validations [EXG].

2 FORMS AND ENTRY POINTS

There are two distinct sets of disclosures required from three kinds of funds encompassed by the FND taxonomy. These separate parts are organized as XBRL taxonomy *entry points*:

- `oef`: Disclosure for each series of an open-end fund on Form N-1A – Summary of Definition of Terms in Fund Name
- `cef`: Disclosure for a closed-end fund on Form N-2 – Definition of Terms in Fund Name.
- `uit`: Disclosure for a unit investment trust registered on Forms N-8B-2 and S-6 – Definition of Terms in Fund Name.

2.1 Physical Location and Organization

The taxonomy is rooted at URLs of the form:

`https://xbrl.sec.gov/fnd/{version}/`

The 2026 taxonomy is specifically at the base URL:

`https://xbrl.sec.gov/fnd/2026/`

2.2 Versioning

Following the file naming of other standard taxonomies, a file from (for example) a “2nd Quarter 2032” taxonomy schema file containing embedded reference links would be located at `https://xbrl.sec.gov/xyz/2032q2/xyz-2032q2_ref.xsd`.

Following the target namespace conventions of other EDGAR standard taxonomies, the current namespace¹ of the core FND schema is `http://xbrl.sec.gov/fnd/2026` with standard prefix `fnd`. This is analogous to the namespace of the Document and Entity Information schema, `http://xbrl.sec.gov/dei/2026` with prefix `dei`.

An FND taxonomy version of any given year (irrespective of quarter) is normally compatible with any other EDGAR standard taxonomy version of the same year, and incompatible with other years’ versions.

Upon introducing a new taxonomy that has a dependency on another taxonomy with prior year versions still valid in EDGAR, compatible versions of the new taxonomy are published.

¹A namespace URI (uniform resource identifier) is not a URL (uniform resource locator); it does not identify a web address.

2.3 Imports

EDGAR submissions are required, permitted, or disallowed from referencing various files comprising the FND taxonomy, as summarized in Figure 1. All instances requiring a Fund disclosure must refer to the appropriate entry point.

3 FORM N-1A USAGE

Figure 4 quotes the disclosures that open-end funds subject to paragraphs (a)(2)(i) or (a)(3)(i) of rule 35d-1 must include in the discussion of Principal Investment Strategies of the Fund (within the Risk/Return Summary section of Form N-1A).² The disclosures must take account of each term appearing in the fund name in need of definition:

Figure 4. Text of Form N-1A Item 4(a)(1) Instruction

Item 4. Risk/Return Summary: Investments, Risks, and Performance

Include the following information, in plain English under rule 421(d) under the Securities Act, in the order and subject matter indicated:

(a) Principal Investment Strategies of the Fund.

(1) * * *

Instruction: If the Fund is subject to paragraph (a)(2)(i) or (a)(3)(i) of rule 35d-1 [17 CFR 270.35d-1], the Fund’s disclosure provided in response to Item 4(a)(1) must summarize the definitions of the terms used in its name, including the specific criteria the Fund uses to select the investments the term describes, if any. For purposes of this instruction, “terms” means any word or phrase used in a Fund’s name, other than any trade name of the Fund or its adviser, related to the Fund’s investment focus or strategies.

Entry point `fnd-oef` imports OEF taxonomy entry point `oef-rr`. For additional detail see [OEF]. OEF already contains a definition link representing other disclosures in Form N-1A Item 4:

As with all data items in entry point `oef-rr` as detailed in [OEF], the text blocks are also dimensioned according to Series identifier and may be additionally dimensioned by distinct prospectuses in the same submission.

4 FORM N-2 USAGE

Figure 7 quotes the disclosures that closed-end funds subject to paragraphs (a)(2)(i) or (a)(3)(i) of rule 35d-1 must provide in the General Description of the Registrant section of Form N-2.³ The disclosures must take account of each term appearing in the fund name in need of definition:

5 FORMS N-8B-2 AND S-6 USAGE

Figure 8 quotes the additional disclosures that trusts subject to paragraph (a)(2)(i) or (a)(3)(i) of rule 35d-1 must provide in the General Description of the Trust and Securities of the Trust section of Form N-8B-2. The disclosures must take account of each term appearing in the fund name in need of definition. Figure 9 quotes the section of Form S-6 that incorporates the disclosure requirements of N-8B-2.

There is currently no taxonomy for Unit Investment Trusts; entry point `fnd-uit` imports only the DEI taxonomy. It has a single role with the same arrangement of concepts and relationships as the entry point for Form N-2.

6 PRESENTATION AND LABEL RELATIONSHIPS

The FND taxonomy entry points have embedded presentation relationships to minimize the need for filer customization. While filers may have some discretion to define aspects such as order of presentation or abbreviated labels, the rendering of the data is of secondary concern to the accuracy and completeness of the content.

6.1 Custom relationships (required)

In general, submissions using entry points `fnd-oeef` and `fnd-cef-pre` do not require any custom presentation or label relationships. Entry point `fnd-uit` requires no labels or presentation for `fnd` concepts. Entry point `fnd-cef` contains neither labels nor presentation and requires filers to provide all relationships of both types. Because there are EDGAR-specific validations that require certain facts to appear in a submission, label and presentation relationships are required as well. The table below indicates which entry point in the FND taxonomy includes the necessary label and presentation relationships, and which do not.
